6. REGULATIONS

- 1. University authorities ensure the protection, safety and smooth stay of students, as well as the safeguarding of the University's property.
- 2. The acceptance and compliance with these regulations constitute a prerequisite for admission and stay in the dormitory. Violations of these regulationς may result in the issuance of warning, dismissal from the dormitory and/or from the University depending on the violation.
- 3. The use, storage or sale of alcoholic beverages in the dormitory, as well as smoking in all indoor areas of the University is strictly prohibited.
- 4. You are not allowed to use any cooking appliances in your rooms. You must use the designated common kitchen areas for cooking purposes. Students are responsible for the cleanliness of the kitchen.
- 5. All emergency exits, stairways and hallways must be at all times accessible.
- 6. Pets are not allowed in the dormitory and in the premises of the University in general.
- 7. It is strictly prohibited to interfere with the electromechanical facilities of the University. In case of any damage please contact immediately the technical services or the University reception.
- 8. Students may not partake in activities that would disturb the studying or quality of rest of other inhabitants in the dormitories. These include but not limited to loud talking, loud music and all kinds of loud noises and sounds.
- 9. The common quiet hours are between 10:00 a.m. 08:00 p.m.
- 10. The cost of repairing any damage to rooms, furniture and common areas will be covered by those responsible for the damage made and the relevant amount will be deducted from the security deposit. In case the cost exceeds the security deposit, then the student will be charged with the difference.
- 11. For the protection of the students we have fire extinguishers located in public spaces as well as smoke detectors in each room. Any interference or tampering with this equipment is strictly prohibited. The storage of flammable and explosive materials and hazardous chemicals is strictly prohibited in the University areas.
- 12. Room change is not allowed without the permission of the Campus Director.
- 13. Visiting hours are between 08:00 a.m and 10:00 p.m on all days of the week. Any visit or overnight stay after visiting hours should be declared at the reception, with the presentation of the tenant's student card.
- 14. The fee of each period of stay should be paid in advance. In case of termination/interruption of stay the fees for the corresponding period (semester) are not refundable.
- 15. In case of key loss, students will be charged with the amount of €50 for replacement.
- 16. Students moving out of dormitories must remove all personal belongings at the time of departure. Any items left in the room, will be deemed as unwanted and will be disposed of.
- 17. The University reserves the right of room inspection whenever it is considered to be necessary.
