

How to...? The Library in seven questions

How can I borrow a book?

To borrow a book you need to have a Library Card. Then you can borrow a book according to your status and the book status. See more info inside.

Can I renew a book?

Yes, you can. You only need to contact the Library on time and ask for renewal. Renewal is given provided that the book is not reserved by someone else.

How can I reserve a book?

If a book that you wish to borrow isn't available, then you can ask the librarians to reserve it for you. You can ask to reserve either the first available copy, or an exact copy of a book.

What if I delay to return a book?

Then a fine is applied. For each day you delay to return a book, you are charged 30 cents.

How can I have access to the electronic resources?

You can have access by providing your institutional credentials (your surname as username and your card ID as a password) to the system when asked.

But how do I search the electronic resources?

You can search them either by Encore, our federated search engine that searches Google-wise, or by ResearchPro, a more sophisticated search engine. Material at the level of titles can be searched through Web OPAC. Please ask the librarian to hand you the respective leaflet.

How can I print in the Library?

You can visit the Computer Lab and print your material. Printing cards are available at the Circulation Desk for the price of 5 or 10 Euros. Copying machines are also available in the Library. You can copy A4 size pages for 5 cents per page and A3 for 10 cents.

NUP Library Profile

NUP Library is part of the Learning Resources Center. It is located on the ground floor of the University Building.

The Neapolis University Pafos Library provides access to a rich collection of resources, from printed books to electronic databases. It supports the educational and research mission of Neapolis University and its scholar communities. The Library also serves the local and Cypriot community through the External type of users.

NUP Library is staffed by dynamic information professionals who offer innovative and flexible services to the Library users.

The Library opening hours are:

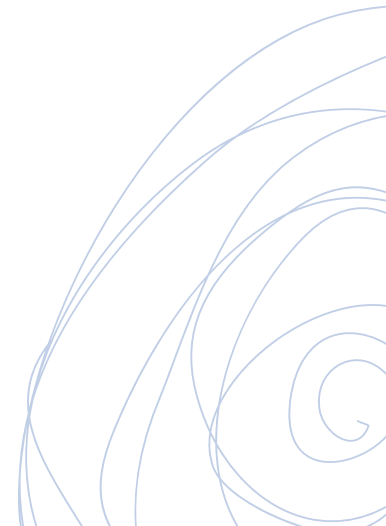
- Monday to Friday: 08:00-20:00

Collections

- Collection of scientific books, relevant to the academic disciplines curated in NUP
- Limited non-academic content meeting the broader fields of interest of the academic and the local community
- Reference material (dictionaries, encyclopedias, handbooks, reports)
- On-line resources: e-journals, e-books, scientific databases
- Digital collections: cultural heritage collections, relevant to Pafos, Cyprus and Europe, as well as institutional repository for NUP dissertations and theses, institutional documents, etc.
- Multimedia resources: audio-visual, CDs and DVDs

Services

- Access to Search and Retrieval services, such as our Web OPAC, aggregators, scientific search engines, etc. Access to scientific databases, including both bibliographic databases and full-text ones.
- Circulation (loan, return, book, renew).
- In house-use of print material (serials and reference works, both no-loan)
- Interlibrary loan and document delivery services
- Access to electronic journals and electronic books.
- Research-enabling tools, such as bibliographic management solutions
- Information literacy seminars; library introduction and orientation sessions, guidance to use effectively resources and tools, etc.
- Provision of reference and support services, both through physical and electronic means.
- Reading rooms, including open and silent zones.
- Workstations
- Printing, scanning and photocopying facilities
