



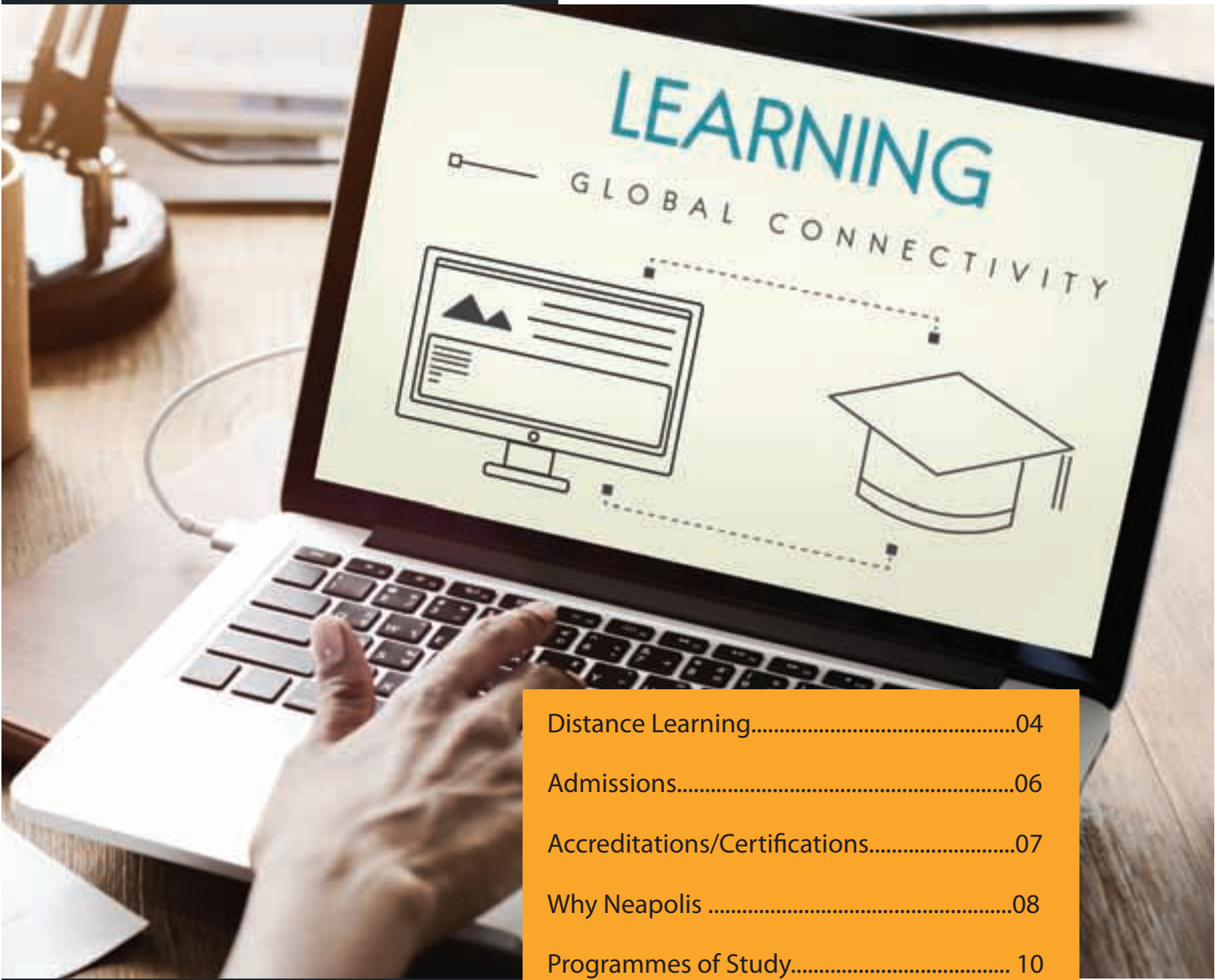

This electronic educational platform used by Neapolis University is designed to achieve the best learning outcomes for students. Face to Face Training

Besides the videotaped lectures and instructions that are available to students, Neapolis University has leased an exclusive line for use of the distance learning programmes that are offered remotely. So the impersonal character and anonymity of distance education is diminished because students can see live, in specially designed areas, the professor or an expert and to ask questions and enjoy the positive results from the virtual student participation from various regions of Greece and Cyprus.

Online Resources

The resources for the online e-learning include educational materials available for reading of each course, links to websites, online communications and multimedia. The tools of the platform make it easier for students and teachers to interact with the various forms of training material and participate in learning through the sharing of knowledge. Entry requirements for applicants:

- **Copy of Bachelor Degree and transcripts**
- **International Passport copy**
- **English Language Proficiency**
 - (I.E.L.T.S 5 and above, TOEFL 70 and above).

For those who do not meet language requirements a foundation year or intensive summer English language course can be offered.

- **NO visa is required**

This approach builds upon participants' existing work experiences, instilling it with new knowledge and experiences applicable to real-life business environments.



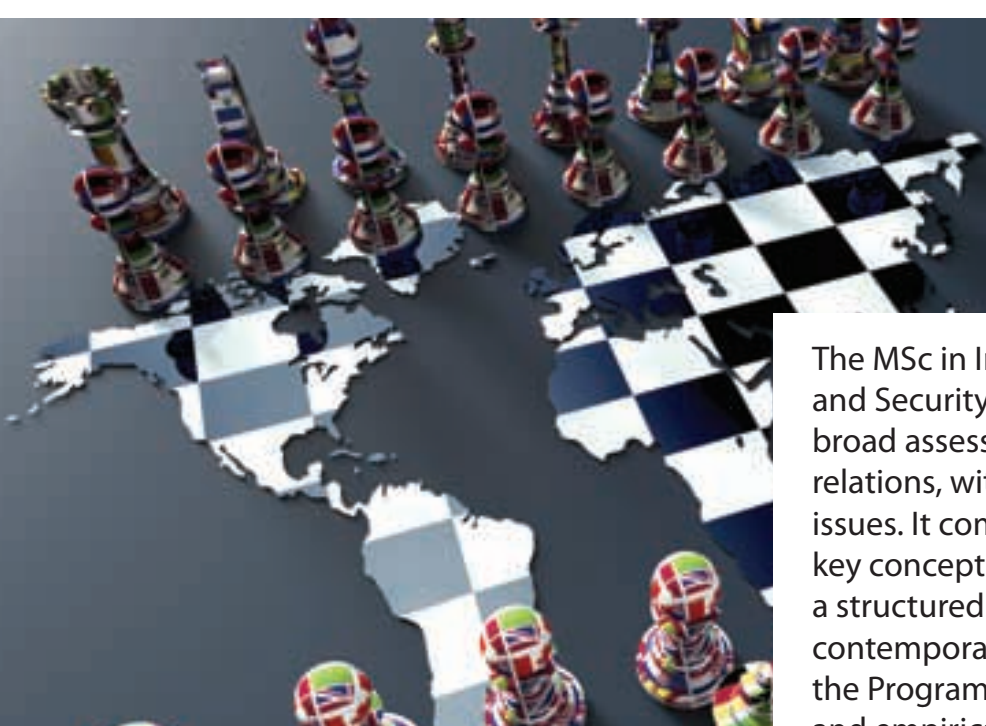
(MSc) Digital Marketing

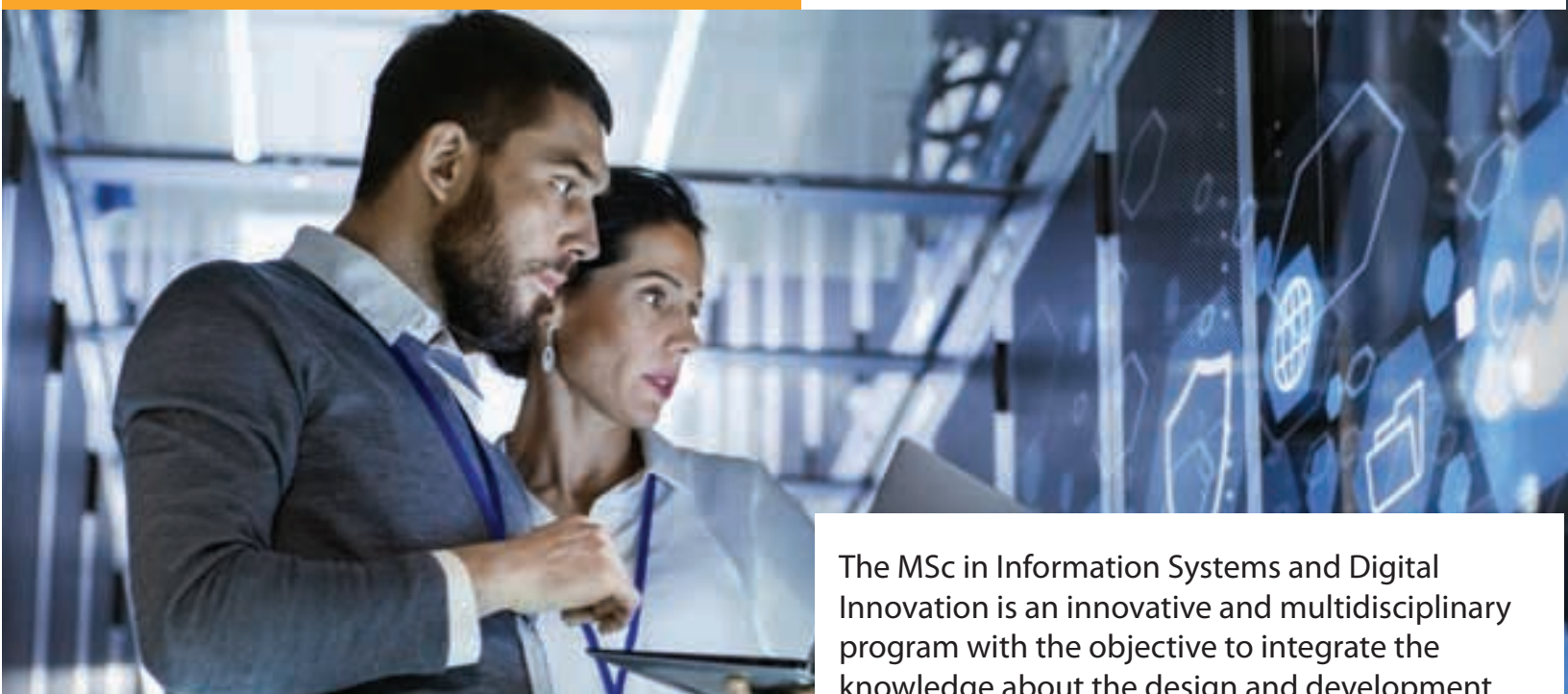

(MSc) International Relations, Strategy & Security

Duration: 3 Acad. sem. or 2 Acad. sem. + thesis
ECTS: 90

The MSc in International Relations, Strategy and Security aims at providing students with a broad assessment of contemporary international relations, with emphasis on strategy and security issues. It combines in-depth academic training in key concepts, theories and case-studies, alongside a structured process of engagement with contemporary debates and experience. Moreover, the Programme provides a strong theoretical and empirical understanding of the international security environment of the post-Cold War era, including the origins of conflicts and peace, the emergence of new security threats and the many different agencies involved in conflict prevention, peacekeeping and peacemaking today. Last but not least, the Programme identifies the ways state and non-state actors develop strategies in the international environment as far as security issues are concerned.



(MSc) Information Systems & Digital Innovation

ECTS: 90

The MSc in Information Systems and Digital Innovation is an innovative and multidisciplinary program with the objective to integrate the knowledge about the design and development of Information Systems with the disruptive technologies of Digital Innovation. The aim of this Programme is to provide a course of advanced study to those who aspire to become effective leaders in European affairs.

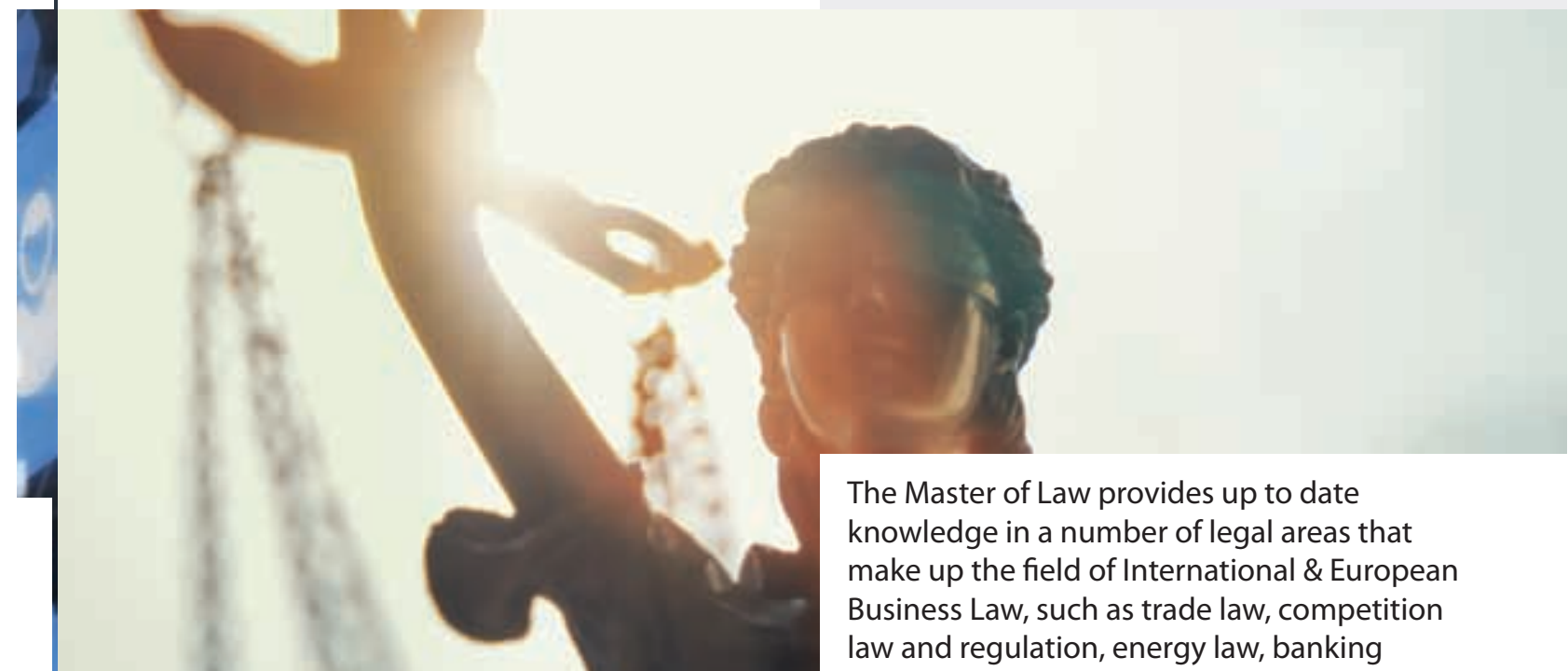
