

## **LECTURER IN QUANTITATIVE METHODS**

### **General description**

### **Qualifications and experience**

In this position you will: design and teach quantitative related units at undergraduate and postgraduate levels to culturally-diverse student cohorts, and provide curriculum development, contribute to the research strengths of the discipline, including the pursuit of research grants and publication in journals of high standing, supervise higher degree research students, be involved in interdisciplinary collaborations within the University and with external stakeholders, contribute to academic administration. In this position you will have to prepare innovative course materials; integrate technology into statistics and quantitative methods courses; design assessments to improve course quality. Assess and maintain student performance records. Develop, revise, distribute and adhere to current course outlines, instructional materials, and/or syllabus. This position is your opportunity to join a high calibre, dynamic group that is well resourced, very research active and teaches a wide variety of business administration courses that attract the very best students from Cyprus and internationally.

Applicants with research interests and experience in one or more of the following areas are especially encouraged to apply:

- Evidence of engagement in interdisciplinary, multi-disciplinary, or transdisciplinary research.
- Understanding ways to collect and analyze data using statistical packages (SPSS, R)

The applicants should hold a doctoral degree **in Econometrics or Quantitative Methods or Statistics or Economics or in related fields**. The applicants will be reviewed based on their research, teaching and activity in the scientific community.
