The Department of Psychology of Neapolis University offers an undergraduate degree in Psychology, two postgraduate programs in Educational and Counseling Psychology, a distance learning program in Educational Psychology and a PhD in Psychology.

Required Qualifications

The required qualifications, depending on the rank, are:

- PhD in Research Methodology or another field in psychology with a strong emphasis on research methodology
- Previous academic experience, evidence of research and scientific contribution, experience in organizing high quality undergraduate and graduate programs (in case the application is for the rank of Assistant).
- The language of instruction is Greek but the university has applied for courses being taught in English as well.
- Candidates do not have to be citizens of the Republic of Cyprus. However, their significant involvement in the operations of the university is required.
- The possibility of teaching in English will be substantially taken into account.

Desired Qualifications: Strong interpersonal and teaching skills will be an asset.
