





HOW TO FIND PRINTED MATERIAL (books & journals)

To locate a book on the shelf make a note of the call number (see example below i.e Call No. PN1995.B67 2013)


To read the full text of an Academic Journal, we click on the “*Access options*” button and we choose one of the two options appeared “*PDF*” or “*Online full text*”.



HOW TO SAVE, PRINT, E-MAIL A FULL TEXT ARTICLE

By opening the text of the document, we have the possibility with the options given to us at the top of the page, to download it, to translate it, to save it in our account for future use, to print it, to create references, to save it in a folder, share it, etc.

To search using more than one field we click on the «*Advance Search*» option.

Then we type the key-words we need in order to limit our results (ex. art and European)

HOW TO REFINE RESULTS

After we click on the “*All filters*” button, from the menu that appeared on the right side of the page, we can choose the type of material such as books, e-books, academic journals, reviews, conference materials ,etc.. Additionally, we can limit the number of the results by choosing a publication date, language, subject etc.
