



SELECTING AN INSTITUTION

ACCESS TO DATABASES AND PUBLISHERS

After logging in to the MyAthens platform, the page presents the following options and features:

- 1. Resource Search:** Type the name of a database, publisher, or other digital resource for quick access.
- 2. Filter by Initial Letter:** Click a letter (A–Z) or “All” to display resources that start with the selected letter.
- 3. Favorites:** Πατήστε το εικονίδιο καρδιάς δίπλα σε κάθε πόρο για να τον προσθέσετε στα Αγαπημένα σας και να τον βρίσκετε πιο γρήγορα στο μέλλον.
- 4. Resource List:** Includes all available databases and publishers with a brief description and a link to the corresponding website.
- 5. Institution Contact Details:** Provides the name of the contact person, email, phone number, and a link to the Learning Resources page.
- 6. Left-hand Column Navigation:**
 - **Research zone:** Return to the main resource list.
 - **Account:** View your MyAthens account information.
