**Job Responsibilities:**

- Development of Syllabi for conventionally offered programs and Study Guides for programs offered through distance learning, in collaboration with the University's academic staff and the Unit of Instructional Design and Learning Process, utilizing new technologies to integrate interactive and student-centered learning tools.
- Provision of support and technical assistance to instructors responsible for developing fully online, hybrid, and conventional courses on Moodle.
- Support in managing Moodle each semester to ensure proper course setup for hybrid and face-to-face courses.
- Provision of technical assistance to instructors in the use of integrated e-learning tools (e.g., Turnitin, H5P, etc.).
- Quality assurance of new courses in Moodle and recommendation of improvements to teaching staff.
- Filming and editing video clips and audio files for integration into online courses. Identification and editing of graphics for use in educational material.
- Provision of e-learning technical support for students, instructors, and staff.
- Communication with the University's IT department to resolve recurring issues.
- Management and completion of projects within specific timelines, while prioritizing and working on multiple projects simultaneously.
- Clear and concise communication, both verbally and in writing.
- Facilitation of the use of new learning and teaching techniques and instructional technologies, including emerging technologies, in creative and collaborative ways.
- Delivery of seminars to teaching staff on the use of educational technology.
- Performance of other assigned duties.

- Very good knowledge of Moodle.

- Familiarity with Learning Management Systems and modern educational technologies.

- Ability to work independently.
- Proven ability to provide remote technological support.
- Detail-oriented with creativity, attention to detail, and collaborative work approaches.
- Experience in graphic design and audio/video editing will be considered an advantage.
- Proven ability to work both independently and as part of a collaborative/team environment, acting as an enthusiastic and flexible team member.
