

# List of Required Documents (March Applications)

1. **Identification & Certificates**
  - Identity cards (both sides) of the student and applicant.
  - Birth certificate of the student.
  - Student ID card (where applicable).
2. **High School Leaving Certificate**
  - High School diploma or equivalent qualification.
3. **Enrollment / Attendance Certificates**
  - Enrollment certificate for academic year 2025–2026.
  - For semester/term-based studies: certificates for all semesters/terms with ECTS credits.
  - In case of discontinued studies: transcript or withdrawal confirmation.
4. **Students in Extended Studies**
  - Medical certificate from a government doctor and
  - Academic transcript showing exam participation periods.  
(The extension must fall within the normal duration of studies.)
5. **Bank Details**
  - Certificate from a Cypriot bank with IBAN in the name of the beneficiary.
  - Accounts held by universities or institutions are not accepted.
6. **Military Obligations (where applicable)**
  - Certificate of completion, deferment, or exemption from military service  
(Cypriot male students only).
7. **In Case of Divorce**
  - Copy of divorce decree.
  - Court order or proof of child support payments (where applicable).
8. **In Case of Parental Abandonment**
  - Certificates from competent government authorities  
(e.g. Social Welfare Services or Police).
9. **Family Status Certificates**
  - Marriage certificate (for married students or applicants).
  - Death certificate of parent or spouse (for orphaned or widowed students/applicants).
10. **Tuition Fees (where applicable)**
  - Proof of payment issued by:
    - the educational institution, or
    - a bank transaction, or
    - credit card payment.

- If tuition is not clearly indicated, an invoice or detailed receipt is required.
- For studies in the United Kingdom:
  - proof of payment, or
  - confirmation from the Student Loans Company, or
  - payment statement from the student's online account.

**11. Other Dependent Children in the Family (if applicable)**

- Military service certificate (for Cypriot conscripts).
- Certificate of enrollment (for university students).
- School attendance certificate (if over 18).
- Medical certificate (for permanent incapacity for self-support).

**12. Family Income (where applicable)**

- Certificates for income from:
  - employment or pensions abroad,
  - rental income or dividends from Cyprus or abroad,
  - other income sources.
- For divorced mothers:
  - court order for alimony or proof of payments for 2025.

**13. Permanent Residence in the Republic of Cyprus (if requested)**

- Certificate from a Community Leader or Local Authority confirming:
  - the family's permanent address, or
  - residence in Cyprus for 50 months within the last five years.
- In special cases:
  - certificates of attendance for Gymnasium and Lyceum.

**14. Medical and Social Criteria (where declared)**

- Medical certificate from a government doctor  
(only for serious health conditions or disabilities considered in the points system).
