

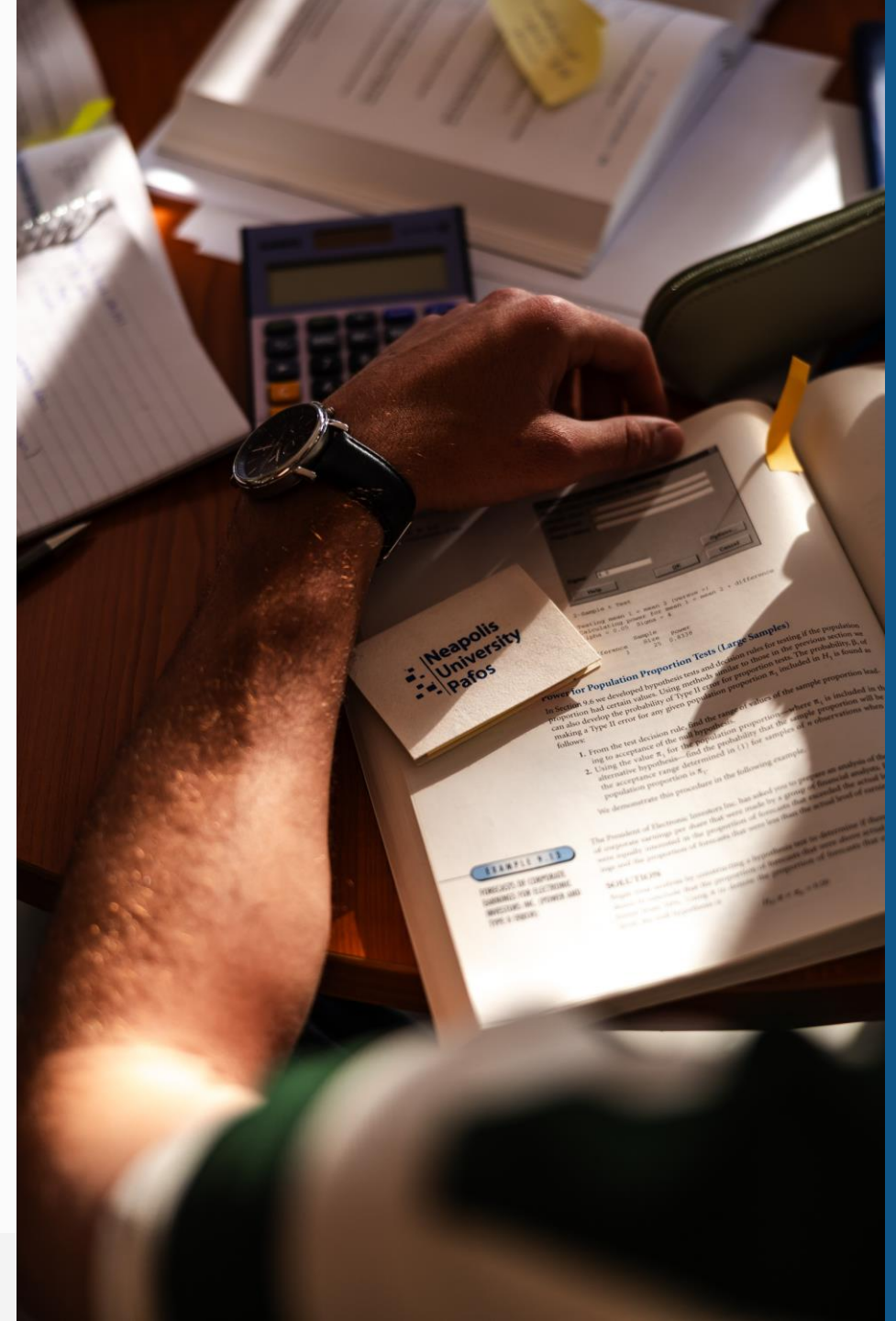





2. After successfully logging in, you will be redirected to the OpenAthens page.





The MyAthens platform displays all the databases, publishers, and other resources subscribed to by the Neapolis University Library, with links directing you to the corresponding websites.



ACCESS TO DATABASES AND PUBLISHERS

After logging in to the MyAthens platform, the page presents the following options and features:

1. **Resource Search:** Type the name of a database, publisher, or other digital resource for quick access.
2. **Filter by Initial Letter:** Click a letter (A–Z) or “All” to display resources that start with the selected letter.
3. **Favorites:** Πατήστε το εικονίδιο καρδιάς δίπλα σε κάθε πόρο για να τον προσθέσετε στα Αγαπημένα σας και να τον βρίσκετε πιο γρήγορα στο μέλλον.
4. **Resource List:** Includes all available databases and publishers with a brief description and a link to the corresponding website.
5. **Institution Contact Details:** Provides the name of the contact person, email, phone number, and a link to the Learning Resources page.
6. **Left-hand Column Navigation:**
 - **Research zone:** Return to the main resource list.
 - **Account:** View your MyAthens account information.
